I am dropping you a quick note on Behalf of Doug Schieffer's heliport currently under a conditional use permit. Our house at 26475 Wyldeewood Dr. Is approximately 600-700' as the crow flies to the helipad. In all honesty we have yet to hear the helicopter while in our home. I have thought I heard it several times and headed outside to watch but it turned out to be bedding in the clothes dryer on one occasion and the other occasion was actually a neighbor on his lawn mower. I did get to see it once when I was in the garage with the door open and I could faintly here the turbine winding up, I went outside to watch and it was surprisingly quiet and over in the matter of a couple of minutes. Having grown up tending Agricultural helicopters on our farms every year spraying the pea and sweet corn fields I was expecting a lot more noise.
